NARRATIVE

I responded to the intersection of Campbell and Spring in reference to a bicyclist that was struck by a car. Upon my arrival I made contact with paramedics who stated that the bicyclist was okay and refusing to go to a hospital. The paramedic also provided me with the license plate number of the vehicle that had hit the bicyclist and stated that the vehicle had left the scene and a witness had taken down the license plate number.

I spoke with the victim Leonard Salazar who said he was traveling southbound in the bike lane when he approached the intersection of Campbell approaching Spring when the listed BMW hit him and the next thing he knew he was on the ground. Mr. Salazar said he was "sore" but did not want to go to the hospital because he could not afford to go. Mr. Salazar said he was wearing his bike helmet when he was struck and that his bike had been damaged and he was unable to ride it any longer.

The listed witnesses were interview and all gave the same account that the vehicle was traveling northbound set up to make the left hand turn onto Spring from Campbell when Mr. Salazar approached. Witnesses stated that it looked as if the driver started to proceed, hesitated then continued to make the turn cutting Mr. Salazar off causing him to collide with the car. Witnesses said they told the driver to pull over at which point he did. Witnesses also said that the driver got out of his car, looked at the damage and stated, "that sucks." Witnesses said the driver then said "I'm in enough trouble already" and went back to his car prior to leaving the scene. Witness, Mr. Toth provided the driver's license plate number and stated that the vehicle fled northbound on Campbell from the scene.



I had PCSO check the address listed on the vehicle return, however the vehicle was not present. A telephone number of 520-4900-088 was located for the owner of the vehicle, however I received voicemail on contact.
